

Download Manual For Central Machinery 12x36

The 12 x 36 is definitely set up for inches. I am almost certain that this is also true for the 13 x 40. Have you downloaded the manual from the HF site for both lathes and studied them? I have a near new enco 12X24 lathe that is excess to my needs. Enco refers to it as a 12X36 but the bed is 36 inches long usable length is more like 24 or maybe 26 inches the swing is definately 12 inches. 12 speed dual belt drive with back gear around 70 to 1000 rpm. I cleaned about half of the cosmoline off some of the parts. the ways and every other bearing surface looks new and tight. Hi Ya'll - i have a 3 in 1 machine and now have a forum to discuss setup, tooling, etc for people with smaller lathe / milling machines - Is anyone else... According to my lathe manual I needed the 1" 8TPI. The adapter arrived quickly. It was a beautiful piece of tool. Unfortunately it was too big for my headstock.
